

Liza's Garden

Liza's garden is actually very small. Against its north terrace wall it has a rose she planted and cared for. In this wall, behind her rose, Liza's ashes will rest in a discreet small alcove. We have just planted two peony bushes in front and three more on the terrace above. The garden will have a bench and a table.

With Thierry Deleuze and Roland Ibanès we are preparing a series of places around Liza's garden for plants in memory of Liza. Here is a first plan prepared by Thierry :

Pour les arbres : Olivier(2), Mauves en arbre(11), Hibiscus(12), Pommier"Reine des Reinettes"(1).

Pour les arbustes : Spirée du Japon (4), Weigelia(6), Buddleia (arbre aux papillons)(7), Cognassier du Japon(8), Deux Hortensias(3).

Pour les grimpantes : Clématite (5).

Une plante herbacée plus petite : Dicentra Coeur de Marie (9).

Et comme plantes de rocaille : Deux Corbeilles d'argent ou d'or (10).

Emplacements : 14 plantes en tout.

- A côté du platane : (7)
- Entre les buis après le pêcher : (2)
- Le long de la route de bas en haut : (8), (6), (4), (11), (12).
- Entre les buis, devant les 3 chênes verts : (1).
- Devant le Studio 3 : (3). (2 plantes)
- Dessous les escaliers : (5).
- Au dessus des escaliers : (10). (2 plantes).
- Quelque part... : (9).

You need to know Malérargues to work out what this means: mainly around Liza's garden, on the South side of the road as it bends down towards the château. The olive tree (2) is reserved for Vicente (he is on the photograph with Liza, harvesting grapes.)

Roland and Thierry will prepare the holes for planting. I will prepare the stone terracing around them. This will take time but should be ready for summer.

You can chose a plant or offer a contribution. Prices vary between 5 and 40 euros. We will confirm the purchases and work out how to make payments. Thierry who has worked at the local nursery Pépinière Martre will collect and plant them.
