Descent to the Underworld

Engraving from the *Capricci* series by Giovanni Batista Tiepolo, the great Baroque Rococo painterdecorator of 18th c. Venice, a series he kept private till his death in 1774: the last execution of a witch in Europe, <u>Anna Göldi</u>, was in 1782 in Switzerland!

These engravings are mostly necromantic consultations - grand oracular magic. And this engraving is perhaps the most explicit. The master (called *Oriental*) consults the very figure of death, while she consults a large book (wearing freemasonic chasuble and emblems?) He reclines on a tomb.

I choose this image rather than a <u>Gustave Doré</u> illustration of Dante's hell, whose vision is (still/already) caught in Christian punitive eschatology.

A *Nekyia* is a descent into the pagan hell, the UNDERWORLD, the kingdom of Hades, world of the dead, the ancestors, memory, culture, where, according to James <u>Hillman</u>, death, memory, theater and dreams come together and merge.
